School Safe Parking Enforcement

Nottinghamshire County Council uses CCTV cars to enforce parking outside of schools. They visit every school in Nottinghamshire and will record whilst passing the details of any cars parked illegally. The vehicle owners will receive a Penalty Charge Notice a few days later and over 1500 of these have been issued to date. A second vehicle has recently been deployed so visits to schools will increase significantly. **Parents are reminded not to park on the restrictions outside of the school in any circumstances.** As you know, these restrictions are in place to provide a safe area outside of the school where the children will gather or cross the road and we ask for your help in keeping this area free of parked vehicles. The school can directly request enforcement from the cars and as some of you have expressed concerns regarding parking, we have requested an additional visit from the enforcement team.
