## School Uniform

As you are aware, we have been tightening up on school uniform following a gradual dip in standards. Children have all been reminded that large brightly coloured bows (including JoJo Bows), themed headgear (flags, cat ears etc.) and bracelets must not be worn for school. If pupils are found wearing these items, they will be asked to remove them. We do not consider makeup or nail varnish to be appropriate for school either although our school uniform policy has never specified this in the past. For now, we ask that parents and carers support us in trying to improve the overall standard of dress. We will officially update the policy ready for the new school year.

### So what uniform should be worn?

In PE, pupils should wear a white t-shirt or t-shirt in their house colours. On the bottom half they should have plain black shorts, sports leggings or tracksuit bottoms. They must wear trainers (or plimsolls/trainers indoors) and jewellery should be removed.

In the classrooms, pupils should have trousers (not jeans or leggings), shorts, skirt or pinafore in black or grey and this should be worn with either the white or blue polo shirt/shirt and a royal blue jumper, cardigan or fleece. In the summer they can choose to wear a blue and white summer dress. We ask that socks and tights be black, white or grey in colour. Shoes should be black with no other colours and trainers are not to be worn, except for PE or break times.

Headbands/ accessories should be discrete. Pupils may wear a watch and an item of jewellery for religious purposes (such as a small cross on a chain) and should contact the school if they wish to vary their uniform in any other way for religious reasons.

## Class Trips

If your child is in Birch Class, the final day for payment for the Warwick Castle trip is Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> June (tomorrow). Based on voluntary contributions, we will make a decision about whether it is viable for the visit to go ahead. If we have to cancel, we will let you know and reimburse you. Hopefully, we will get the last few payments in tomorrow.

If your child is in Elm Class and you have not yet returned your White Post Farm reply, please do so at your earliest convenience. Thank you.
