Sun Safety & Staying Hydrated

What hot weather! Thank you for sending your children with sunhats and water bottles, wearing sunscreen. This really is vitally important as we want to protect them as much as possible from the harmful rays of the sun.

During hot weather, we open up the school garden during break times so that there are larger areas of shade for the children to escape to. Please send your child with a sun hat as this gives them protection wherever they are on the playground.

We have some exciting news! Drinking water taps have recently been fitted both inside and out. These taps provide water specifically for drinking and are places where the children can refill their bottles hygienically. Children are therefore not to drink directly from the tap and this has been explained to them. The success of this relies on parents sending them to school with a water bottle that can be re-filled whenever necessary.

Our thanks go to Luke Richardson (Parent Governor) who facilitated arrangements for this in addition to replacement taps for all of the sinks across school that are used by pupils. The new taps are easier for young children to use and automatically switch off to save water wastage.
